

## Appointment of three Trustees

The National Library of Wales creates cultural and economical value for the people of Wales by leadership and working in partnership. We remove obstacles to information, develop skills to create information and preserve information for future generations.

The Library is eager to appoint three new Trustees and to take advantage of this opportunity to tackle the gender imbalance of the Board, as well as trying to achieve a Board which is more representative of the various communities we serve.

As a Board member, you will be eager and enthusiastic in providing the Library with strategic leadership, helping the Library to provide first class services, face challenges creatively, scrutinise its performance and make the Library more relevant to the differing needs of our communities.

We would like to recruit individuals with experience of working in one of the following areas; strategic planning, digitisation, collections management, media and broadcasting, fundraising and sustainability, and international networking, but this is not essential.

Trustees are not remunerated, but we will pay travelling and other reasonable costs. The appointment is made in consultation with Welsh Government and will be made based on merit following a fair, open and transparent competition, and will be for a period of four years from 1 March 2020.

There are no linguistic conditions attached to these appointments. Trustees can work in whichever language they choose, and translation facilities will be available at all Board meetings.
