The main interest in the Churchill material consists of memoranda, minutes, instructions and correspondence which passed between Sir Winston and his Financial Secretary on the question of the Expansion of Dockyard Labour in 1940; a typescript memorandum (29 May 1940) from the Prime Minister to his Ministerial colleagues and high officials, urging them to 'maintain a high morale in their circles'; a circular letter (12 May 1940) from the Prime Minister addressed to G. H. Shakespeare, then the Secretary of the Department of Overseas Trade, thanking members of the late Administration who were continuing at their posts pending the reconstruction of the Ministry ; a letter from Sir Winston accepting an offer to speak at the Cambridge Union Oxford debate in 1921 ; and various correspondence between Sir Winston Churchill and Sir Geoffrey Shakespeare, 1945-51.

The archive also contains a few letters addressed by Sir Owen M. Edwards to Hughes & Son, Wrexham, 1894-5; correspondence in October and November 1917 between R. Silyn Roberts, Joseph J. Williams, and Thomas Jones relating to the appointment of a representative of agricultural labourers to a Government Committee; a letter of 26 May 1926 from Ernest Bevin to J. W. Williams concerning the attitude of his union to the Miners' Lock-out; and a copy of a letter, 16 June 1964, from Miss Jennie Lee to Jack Hylton, commenting on a film about her husband's life and on his attitude to nuclear weapons.

There is an interesting collection of press cuttings covering in the main the years 1932-53 and 1956-67, dealing chiefly with events in which H. T.
