All these items, with the exception of the manuscript additions to the Memoir and a copy of a translation from the Hebrew, are in the hand of 'Dic Aberdaron'. The letters and notes vividly illuminate his life of itinerant scholarship, and his dependence on his benefactors.

He explains that the money, £5 per annum, was used to defray travelling expenses during his tour through Wales, Cornwall, Brittany, Ireland and Scotland collecting material for the project. Lhuyd's work was completed in a reasonable period of time and so the responsibility for its late appearance rests with the printers. The reasons for the book's delay have been set out in the volume's Welsh preface. As a result of the delay, Lhuyd was able to enlarge the work somewhat. He also mentions that he has received complimentary letters regarding the volume from Dr Hicks [George Hickeys, 1642-1715, Dr Gibson of Lambeth [Edmund Gibson, 1669-1748], and others.
