

## **APPOINTMENT OF TREASURER**

The Library's Board of Trustees invites applications for the non-executive post of Treasurer. The Treasurer is the lead Trustee on all the Library's financial issues, is involved in regular discussions with the Chief Executive, as the Library's Accounting Officer, and other senior Library staff and is responsible for presenting the Annual Accounts to the Board.

The Treasurer will have an understanding of the financial control and compliance requirements of a large organisation and a sufficient level of technical financial expertise to appreciate the range of financial issues with which the Library must deal. He/she need not necessarily be a qualified accountant but will have considerable experience in a senior financial or managerial role and if possible some experience of fundraising.

Trustees are not remunerated but may claim travel and other reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of the Board. The appointment will be made in consultation with the Welsh Government and will be based on merit following a fair, open and transparent competition. Whilst fluency in Welsh is an added advantage it is nevertheless not essential, as simultaneous translation is provided at all Board meetings.

The Treasurer is an *ex-officio* member of the Board's Audit, Risk and Assurance Committee, and will also chair the Board's Finance and Resources Committee. The appointment will be effective from 1 April 2023, but the person appointed will spend the intervening period shadowing the current Treasurer.
