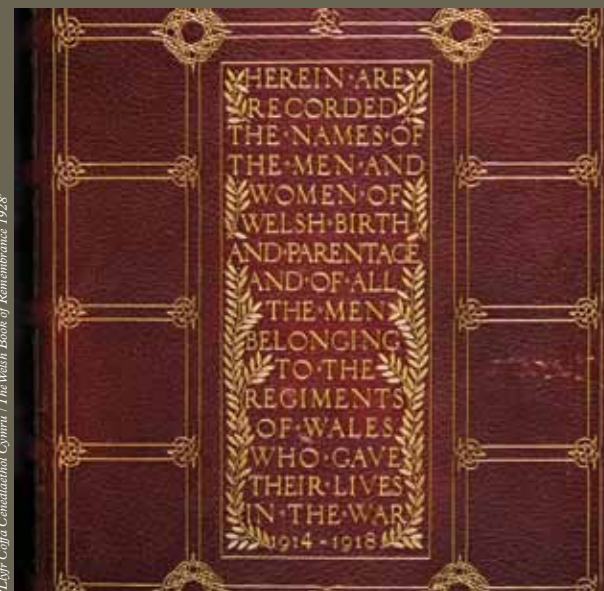

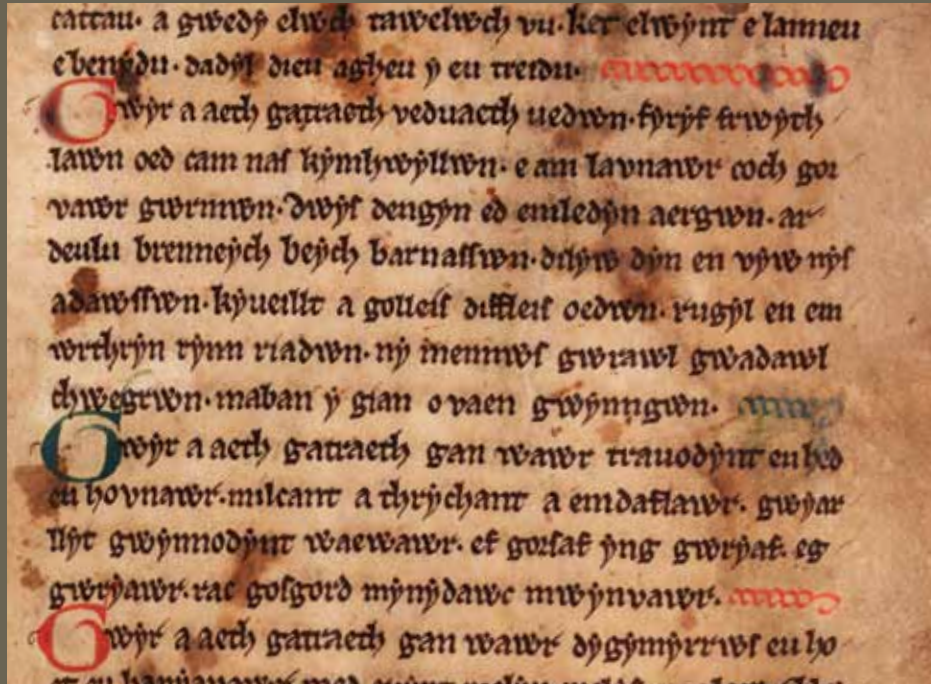

For centuries, Welsh poets and prose writers have depicted the experience of war, either by celebrating victories or mourning defeat. This exhibition focuses on four historic conflicts from the sixth to the seventeenth centuries – both battles and skirmishes. Poignant eyewitness accounts and later reactions by artists such as Aneirin and David Jones, Bleddyn Fardd and Gerallt Lloyd Owen will be shown alongside the narrative testimonies of contemporary and later chroniclers. Let the poets take you to Catraeth, Cilmeri, Bosworth and the Somme.

R. W. Nevinson. Designed to encourage a war-weary public and raise support for the war effort, they show modern political propaganda in its early stages.

### Women and disability in South Wales coalfields – Alexandra Jones

It has been shown that coalfields women near the start of the 20th century were at greater risk of death than their male counterparts. Whilst the arduous work of women in the home was arguably an extension of the coal industry, women also worked both at the colliery and in other local industries. Depictions of female characters are plentiful, but the vast majority of the material was written by men, and writing by working-class women is scarce. This presentation seeks to redress this balance by exploring the representation of women and disability in coalfields literature.

In 1909 the NLW opened to the public in the Assembly Rooms in the town. Over the last two years volunteers have been recording data from the Library's readers' register 1909–12. Calista and the volunteers will present a day in the life of the National Library in 1911, drawing on her PhD project, which explores the connection between the Library and Welsh national identity.

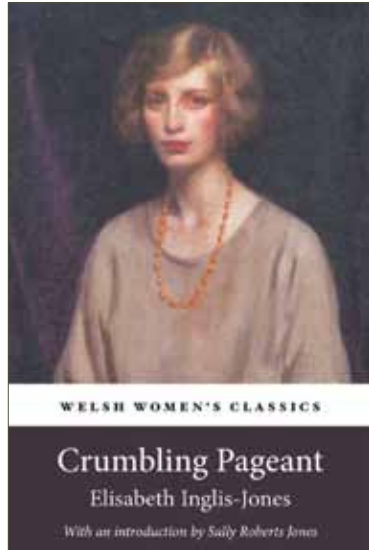

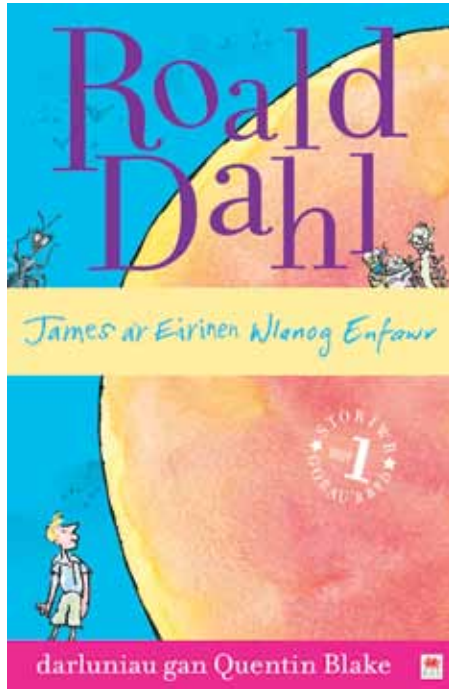

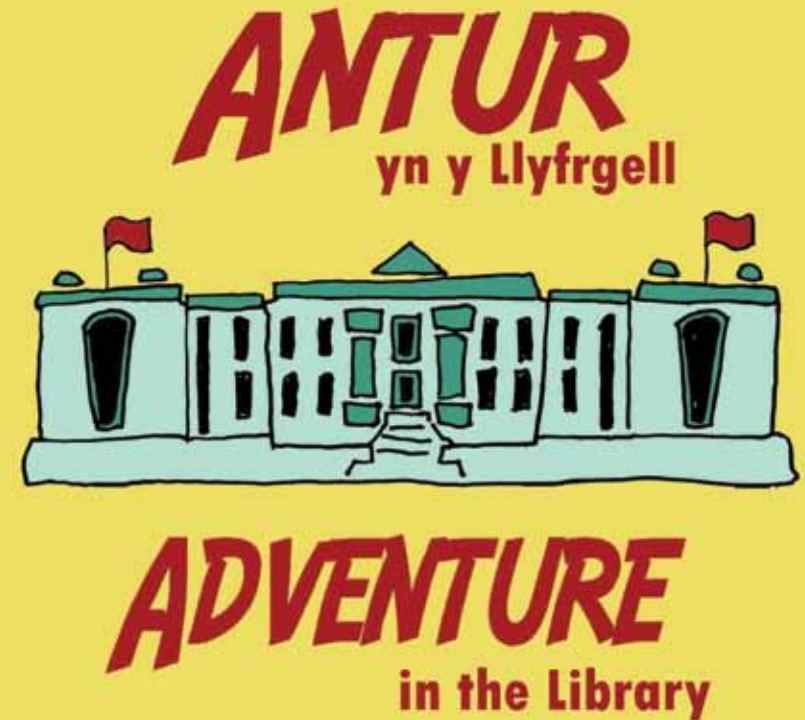
